I want to keep you informed about some of the things I have been doing this first quarter of 2012. Of course, I continue to do many of the same things I do all year thru as that is the job description. However, they are always different and challenging.

I continue to check the local papers daily for obituary notices of anyone having any connection with Poestenkill. These are laminated and filed and are a good source of genealogy.

I am going thru the numerous family genealogies belonging to the Sand Lake Historian. I am borrowing, copying and filing any of those names which are familiar to Poestenkill. This is important since Poestenkill was part of Sand Lake until 1848. I still hope local people will share their family research with us for archival research but don't have much luck with that.

I have had several phone calls and visits from people wanting any information on their family that I have. Most interesting was in February when I spent an afternoon with Joseph Hidley's great, great, great granddaughter. I actually provided her with some information she did not have.

I continue to have problems with the computer in my office so on several occasions have brought things home to work on. I hope Mike and I can get together in the near future and work out the problems.

I have done other research for several people including Eva Gemmill who is working on a booklet of the history of the library up to 1990.

I have attended professional meeting including the Rensselaer County Historians' meeting where we discuss things that are happening within the county and what other historians are doing.

Next month I hope to change out the display case in the entrance to feature our local Fire Company.
