A Resolution was offered by Councilwoman Butler, seconded by Councilman Van Slyke, to approve a settlement of the Hitchcock litigation upon terms and conditions of a proposed settlement agreement. However, before a vote could take place on the proposed Resolution, Councilman Wohlleber spoke at length about this issue. After further discussion, Councilwoman Butler withdrew the Resolution, and no vote was taken.
